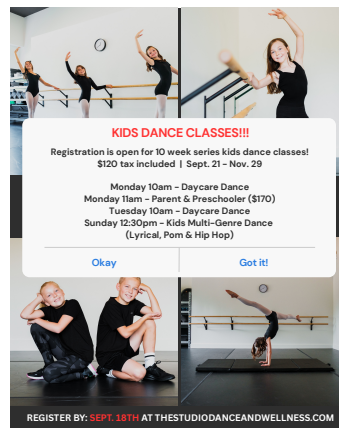
The new school year is sneaking up on us and with that comes our new dance season! Included in this newsletter is everything you need to know to get yourself ready for the season ahead.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

FALL SEMESTER REGISTRATION

Registration for our Fall Semester classes open on **August 1st** with a ton of classes for everyone; Jazz, Hip Hop, Heels & Burlesque, Ballet, Barre Fitness and Bellies, Babies & Barre! Our semester classes are taught at a beginner level to welcome anyone wanting to dance with or without experience. For children, we have Kids Multi-Genre Dance for ages 5+, Parent & Preschooler and two separate Daycare Dance classes for toddlers. All of our semester programming run for 10 weeks with different pricing for adult and children's classes. **Fall Semester begins the week of Monday, September 21st.**

If you haven't taken a class with us in a while, don't worry! Simply login to your Portal and by registering for your desired class, your account will be reactivated. Can't remember your Portal login or password? No problem! Send us an email and we can reset it!



REGISTRATION FOR 2026/2027 SEASON CLASSES

Registration opened July 1st for all our full season classes with the first day beginning on **Monday, September 14th**. To register simply visit your portal through our website here: <https://app.jackrabbitclass.com/jr3.0/ParentPortal/Login?orgId=543345>

Be sure to register your dancer by September 15th in order to receive your complimentary student gift. By registering early, you help us determine which classes will have received enough enrollment to run and thus finalizing our schedule. Our DRAFT schedule for the 26/27 season is now posted on our website and downloadable in a PDF format to print and/or save. Please refer to this schedule when planning for this season but understand that it is a tentative schedule subject to change depending on class enrollments. The new and updated IMPORTANT DATES document is also available on our website to download. When registering for your classes, please add these dates to your calendar to ensure you don't miss out on special events throughout the year like dress rehearsals, shows and closed dates.

COMPETITIVE COMMITMENT & REGISTRATION DEADLINE

New this year we are introducing a COMPANY *commitment* deadline of **August 15th** (this is for competitive dance families only). Dancers simply need to let us know if they'll be joining the competitive team by this date. Dancers will not need to fully enroll until the registration deadline of **September 1st** (the same as last season). With competitive classes taking up most of the schedule, knowing how many students have committed to the year ahead will help our teachers prepare and plan for choreography and support the need for certain classes on the schedule (ie. having two Stretch & Strengthen classes). Please don't hesitate to contact the office if you have any questions. We are available for video calls through the month of August.

ADDITIONAL CLASS INCENTIVE

If your dancer registers for two or more classes this season, you'll receive a voucher for 30% off a one-time purchase at THE STORE. This is an additional class incentive! Vouchers will be handed out in September as classes begin for the season, please don't hesitate to ask for yours in the first weeks of classes as you make your store purchases!

REVIEW YOUR PAYMENT PLAN

Please take the time to check your account to confirm which payment plan you would like to be on. Payment plans do not change year over year, so if there is a change in your circumstance and you'd like a different plan, you'll need to e-mail the office. Families who request to change their payment plan after Sept. 15th, add a large amount of administrative work so it's best to double check this ahead of time.

The first tuition payment of the season is processed on September 20th along with additional fees (registration, photography and costume deposits). A payment schedule is included in the Payment Policies document accessible through your portal.

EARLY SEASON STORE HOURS

THE STORE will be open before classes get started on **Sunday, September 13th from 12:00-3:00pm** for all your dancewear needs. If your child is new to dance this year and they'd like a tour before classes begin, this is a great time to do so!

FALL DANCE CONVENTION

Our studio will be attending Terpsichore Dance Convention in Calgary, AB on **Saturday, November 7th & Sunday November 8th**. This event is open to ALL dancers, both recreational and competitive. Convention is an opportunity to dance outside of our comfort zones and learn from industry professionals. **The registration deadline for convention is August 15th.** Tuition costs for convention is listed below without tax. Ages: Mini (7-9 yrs), JR (10-12 yrs), SR (13 + yrs)
Tuition = Mini \$99.75 (1/2 day), JR & SR \$323.00, Teacher \$175.00
Observer Pass = \$55.00

GUEST CHOREOGRAPHY & ELITE COMPANY

Our elite guest choreographer for the 26-27 season is Miss Taylor Kyriluick from Edmonton, AB! Taylor has extensive experience in both teaching dance and as a professional adjudicator in the industry. Her teaching philosophy aligns with the values of THE STUDIO and we are thrilled to welcome her back to our community. To learn more about Taylor check out our Instagram and Facebook pages.

Competitive dancers who are placed in Level 4 Ballet are eligible to audition for Miss Taylor's Lyrical group. This group will be called the FIRELIGHT COMPANY. Not all dancers who audition will be selected by our guest choreographer but are encouraged to try out! A \$78.57 deposit is required to audition, and dancers must be registered for the class (found within your portal) by **October 1st** to be eligible. If a dancer is not selected the deposit will be added as a credit to the family's account. If a dancer is selected, this amount will be considered the 1st month's tuition for the class.
