ABOUT US



Little Movers Daycare is a licensed childcare facility in Revelstoke, offering multi-age care to children ages 0-8. Our staff know and understand that young children need the chance to ease into time away from home in a structured and nurturing environment. Children will explore movement, music, art, books, mindfulness focusing on both fine and gross motor skills, positive peer time and independence. This program is designed to help foster positive relationships with other children and the community around them.

PARENT TO DO

- Contact THE STUDIO and complete an intake form.
- Send a current photo of your child(ren).
- Send your child(ren) with a water bottle, at least 3 snacks, 1 lunch, an extra change of clothes, pull ups/diapers & wipes (if needed) and wearing weather appropriate clothing for outdoor play.
- Send special need items such as medications, clearly labelled with instructions for use.
- Be sure that all your child's belongings are well labeled.

OUR PROGRAM

Little movers was created from our love of working with children and a desire to offer kids more opportunities to learn through play and movement. We continually strive to build our community and expand our reach to more people in Revelstoke.

Children will be cared for by a qualified and well vetted Early Childhood Educator (ECE) certified with First Aid. They will participate in a wide range of activities throughout the day to keep children engaged including but not limited to: movement, obstacle courses, reading, crafts, music, quiet time and outdoor play following a structured schedule.

Our program values are based on kindness, compassion and creativity. We, and our care providers understand that all children are unique and that being away from their home and family can be challenging. It is our mission to instill confidence and creativity to all the children who come to THE STUDIO and for everyone to feel supported through their experience.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

Your children will be able to find a balance between active play, intellectual activities and quiet time. We believe kids should have time to play and explore but we also understand the importance of learning the age appropriate basics.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMMING

We plan to seek out additional programs for your child to participate in. This may include movement classes at THE STUDIO, tumbling with the Acrobats and more. These classes will be at an additional cost to families and will be communicated with plenty of notice to parents.

OUTDOOR PLAY

The minimum requirement for outdoor play is 90 minutes/day. Our program will aim to exceed these standards when the weather allows it. There are many parks within close proximity that we will walk to on a regular basis.

WHAT THEY'RE LEARNING

Building language, social, and self-help skills; kids will have opportunity to experiment with cause and effect; investigate the outdoors; build relationships; and more.

Younger children will establish early reading skills, sign language to build language development and early communication, and motor skills. They'll start building secure attachments, explore the outdoors, participate in art and music activities, and much more.

POSSIBLE ACTIVITIES

Crafts, dance parties, music class, obstacle courses, free movement, park exploration, library story time, Leap Land visits, Strong Start, Mother Goose, drawing, writing, memory games, problem solving & more.

MORE INFORMATION

INTAKE FORMS: All families are required to fill out an intake form and provide a recent photo of their child. We use these things to create emergency cards for each child as well as to identify allergies, preferences, nap schedules etc.

WAITLIST: Our wait list is first come, first served. Children with siblings already enrolled in the program will be prioritized. To add yourself to the waitlist please e-mail the office with your request including child's name, age of daycare start, birthdate, full time/part time and which days and parent's name.

ILLNESS POLICY: If a child falls ill and is exhibiting contagious symptoms parents will be contacted and the child will be sent home. Once the child is symptom free for 48 hours, they will be welcomed back to care. No refunds or credits can be offered for sick days.

If a care provider falls ill we will do our best to find a suitable substitute. If this is not possible care may be cancelled. In this case a credit will be applied to your account.

NAPPING POLICY: If your child is napping we ask that you send a fitted crib sheet and blanket to be stored at THE STUDIO. Each set of bedding will be stored separately. All sheets and blankets will be washed weekly on Fridays.

ALLERGY POLICY: Our allergy policy will be based on the individual needs of the children enrolled in our program. If the Little Movers Program needs to become a peanut free facility, we will communicate to families not to pack peanuts for their children. Parents will need to understand that our dance program also operates out of the same building and we cannot monitor what other children are bringing into the space. The dance program starts each day at either 2pm or 3pm, and will not have access to the basement area until daycare ends at 4:30pm. At 4:30pm, students from the dance program will have access to lounge and kitchen area. There is more than one area where a child can eat if they need to separate themselves from others to stay safe. Our ECE care provider is trained and up to date with first aid and CPR and can respond appropriately in the event of an emergency.

VACATION POLICY: We will break for a total of 6 weeks throughout the year. 2 weeks over Christmas/New Years, 2 weeks in March and 2 weeks in August. If a family chooses to depart for an extended period of time outside of these closed dates they will be required to pay in order to maintain their child's enrolment. With enough notice we can offer a 50% discount on 5 days while a child is away for 1 week of vacation per year.

PAYMENT POLICY

1. Families must always have a valid, up to date credit card on their account.
2. Families will be auto-charged to their credit card on file on the 1st day of each month.
3. Tuition is calculated by the spot taken up by the child, not how many days they attended that month. Attendance will not be taken into consideration for tuition.
4. Tuition will be calculated in advance based on the number per days in the month. Payments made on the 1st of the month is for the program of that month (ie: payment on September 1st is for programming through the month of September).
5. Failed payments will be given a 7-day grace period with a warning of the declined payment. After 7-days, a \$35.00 plus GST late fee will be posted to the account. Following a declined payment, it is the client's responsibility to complete payment through their portal.
6. If a family requires more time to make a payment, prior notice and a discussion with THE STUDIO directors is required and not guaranteed.
7. If families would like to arrange an alternate payment method (ie. e-transfer, debit or cash), THE STUDIO directors must be informed and payment must be made before the 1st of each month attending care. If the payment is not received by the 1st, the credit card on file will be charged.
8. Families are required to give a full month's written notice to drop out of classes and programs with a \$75.00 drop fee added to their account. Students can still attend until their last paid day, if they'd like to (ie. notice is given to cancel on Nov.15th, so the child will stop attending care by Dec.15th and still welcome to attend until that date).
